Comment: Jean Hotteterre (died 1720) was a composer and musician of

the Hotteterre family in the court of Louis XIV of France. He and his brothers Jacques-Martin and Nicolas made many enhancements to the hautbois, creating an indoor version similar to the shawm. Jean and Michel Philidore created the oboe. La noce champêtre (Country Wedding/ Pastoral Hymn) is a French Sonata and Trio (No. 6) ca. 1700 in 31 movements.
