He composed it in Leipzig for the seventh Sunday after Trinity and first performed it on 4 August 1726. Bach later used the music from four movements of this cantata for his Missa in G minor, BWV 235. Bach wrote the cantata in 1726 for the seventh Sunday after Trinity as part of his third annual cycle.
