H. A. WOLLENHAUPT.**

The following is a list of new compositions by the very talented composer, H. A. Wollenhaupt. These pieces have met with a success scarce equaled by any Piano composer. His style is fresh and vigorous, and while they charm with their grace and elegance, they educate and refine the taste. The following notice of his valuable work, Op. 41, TWELVE PIECES OF INSTRUCTION, which is taken from the N. Y. *Times*, 2d March, is fully expressive of the general characteristics of Wollenhaupt's music.

"Messrs. Wm. Hall & Son have published a set of twelve instructive Pieces, by H. A. Wollenhaupt, which appear to be the most useful things of the kind we have met with lately. They are short, and issued in six numbers. The intention of the composer is to characterize six different styles of playing, and to make these studies pleasing, useful, and instructive to the pupil. Wollenhaupt is an excellent writer for the Piano-Forte, and never exceeds the capabilities of the class of players for whom he writes. These pieces are neatly made, progressive, and valuable to teachers."
